College/Program Notes:

Assumptions: college-level readiness in MTH & ENG; no Foreign Language Deficiency. Additional requirements apply if these deficiencies exist. Students must earn First Aid and CPR certification on their own and it must be valid to complete Internship. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA to take professional courses above the 200 level. Candidates must earn a C or better in any major field requirement.

The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate from the suggested placement of Gen Ed courses, although the M/QL and W/C requirements should be completed during the first year of study.

Students must have a minimum of 120 total credit hours, of which a minimum of 24 credit hours must be upper division (300 or 400-level courses). Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives as indicated above, or may need additional electives. HHP advisors may recommend specific general education courses; electives must be selected and approved by an HHP advisor to ensure relevance of course work.
