## College/ Program Notes

The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate from *General Electives ensure that a student accumulates the minimum credit hour totals needed for graduation. Students must have a minimum of $\mathbf{1 2 0}$ total credit hours, of which a minimum of $\mathbf{4 2}$ credit hours must be upper division ( 300 or 400 -level courses). Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives as indicated above, or may need additional electives.
