Mus. degree must complete two approved foreign culture courses or two courses in a foreign language beyond the state entrance requirement. College-level readiness in $M T H$ and ENG is also expected.
    The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate fro the suggested placement of Gen Ed courses, although the W/C requirements should be completed during the first year of study, and the M/QL requirements should be complet during the first two years of study.
    *General Electives ensure that a student accumulates the minimum credit hour totals needed for graduation. Students must have a minimum of 120 total credit hours, of which minimum of 42 credit hours must be upper division ( 300 or 400 -level courses). Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives indicated above, or may need additional electives.
