The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate from the suggested placement of Gen Ed courses, although the M/QL and W/C requirements should be completed during the first year of study.

\*Electives ensure that a student accumulates the minimum credit hour totals needed for graduation with an undergraduate degree. Students must have a **minimum of 120 total credit hours**, of which a **minimum of 24 credit hours** must be upper division (300, 400, and 500-level courses if in the 4+1 program) to earn a Bachelor of Science. Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many electives as indicated above, or may need additional electives.

<sup>^</sup>Only one QL course can be applied to the M/QL requirement. The other course must be an MTH/STA course. NOTE: MS requires at least one course in College Statistics

<sup>^^</sup>Other capstone courses are available, although some may require additional prerequisites and may not satisfy WAC requirements. Please see the catalog and/or your advisor for more information.
