**College/ Program Notes:**

The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate from the suggested placement of Gen Ed courses, although the M/QL and W/C requirements should be completed during the first year of study.

\*General Electives ensure that a student accumulates the minimum credit hour totals needed for graduation. Students must have a **minimum of 136 total credit hours**. Depending upon other elective choices made, students may not need as many general electives as indicated above or may need additional electives.

^Students must complete 6 semesters of ensembles. Each of the following 4 MTX ensembles must be successfully completed at least once: MTX 150, 151, 152, 153. For the remaining 2 ensembles, students may take MUS ensembles or repeat MTX ensembles of their choice.

\*\*\*MTX 425 Music Therapy Internship is completed after all coursework and typically lasts 6 months. Students must register for MTX 425 during each semester interning.
