A&H = Arts & Humanities Requirement (2 courses from different departments**) DIV = Social Diversity Requirement (one US Diversity & one African American Exp.)

WAC/SPAC = Writing/Speaking Across the Curriculum (3 courses, one in major)

CAP = Capstone Requirement
