The plan above is a suggested guide to ensure that all General Education, College, University, and Major requirements are met within 4 years of study. Students may deviate from the suggested placement of Gen Ed courses, although the M/QL and W/C requirements should be completed during the first year of study. This plan assumes college-level readiness in both mathematics and English and that Foreign Language Deficiency (FLD) requirements have been met. NOTE: B. Mus. students must complete two approved foreign culture courses or two courses in a Foreign Language beyond the FLD.

INTRO = Introduction to University Life Requirement (one course)

W/C = Writing/Composition Requirement (2 courses; C or better required)

M/QL = Mathematics/Quantitative Literacy Requirement (2 courses) NS = Natural Science (2 courses, one of which must have a lab)

SS = Social Sciences Requirement (2 courses from different departments**)

A&H = Arts & Humanities Requirement (2 courses from different departments**)

DIV = Social Diversity Requirement (one US Diversity & one African American Exp.)

WAC/SPAC = Writing/Speaking Across the Curriculum (3 courses, one in major) CAP = Capstone Requirement

* General Electives ensure that a student accumulates the minimum 120 required credit hours for graduation. Of these 120 credit hours, a minimum of 36 credit hours must be upper division (300 or 400-level courses).

** Of the SS and A&H courses, one must be focused on Africa, Latin America, or the Middle East

Students must register for MUS 120 every semester until the requirement of 6 semesters has been met.
